
Occupational health and safety (OHS) in agriculture

- Agriculture is the sector in Denmark with the most fatal accidents and serious accidents, compared with other sectors
- Many accidents with animals, slurry and machines
- Long-term ergonomic issues
- Estimated underreporting of up to 85%
- The employer has an objective responsibility in terms of OHS
