
## Longevity of sows is a common challenge

- It is hard work to handle dead sows – especially from farrowing crates
  - Most people don't like to kill a sow
  - Everybody wants to work with healthy sows
  - Dead sows cost money – Slaughtered sows pays dkk.12.40 pr kg
  - Motivation – together we can increase the survival rate of the sows
- 
- A good basis for decision-making is important



Slaugt	Dead	Killed	Code/reason	Remarks
			Feed and feeding	Shoulder leasions, Skinny, Prolaps etc.
			Sudden death	Sudden/unexpected for a normal producing sow
			Legs	Leasions/abscesses on the foot/hooves and damage to the joints, legs and hooves
			Farrowing	Poor milker, farrowing problems, retained foetuses, etc.mv.

# Ok for most of you

## – include slaughter and dead/killed sows

Slaught	Dead	Killed	Code / reason	Remarks
			Udder	Udder edema and infections, blind teats, milking poorly
			Skinny	Not ok in the group, cowed, does not eat, assaulted
			Shoulder lesions	
			Reproduction	Lack of heat, not pregnant, low litter size etc.
			Sudden death	Sudden/unexpected for a normal producing sow
			Farrowing	Damage caused by the farrowing, retained fetuses ect.
			Prolaps	
			Foot/Hoof	Lesions/abscess on foot/hoof, torn claws
			Legs	Legs in general, including joint injuries, arthritis, injuries caused by fighting, etc
			Adjustment of the batch	Slaughters due to the size of the weekly batch
			Age	
			Ect.	

# Precise diagnoses improve the focus on sow survival

## 1. Employees

- You do the day-to-day work, and you and your colleagues must be able to recognize the diagnoses similar

## 2. Create an overview

- Diagnoses must be uniform without overlap with other diagnoses, **talk to Olga and your Vet about the choice of diagnoses**

## 3. Set up your management system correctly

- Adjust the systems - only sow diagnoses can be selected for sows and correct culling codes for correct diagnoses



- Based on data from the last year



Intervals of 3, 6, 9 and 12 month






## Sygdomskoder - Selvdøde og aflivede


